This is a long-term IISOH publishing project to increase public awareness and appreciation in the arts as it relates to the history of sport, physical education, recreation, dance, sport in art and the Olympic Games through poster art.

This IISOH uses sports images from the past or recent images from photographers and artists to produce poster art that can be used worldwide to promote the subject of Sport in Art as well as the sport that is illustrated.

Future posters will be for such sports as American Football, Baseball, Basketball, Ice Hockey, Tennis, Wrestling, Fencing and many others.

Each poster is in American size 24 x 36 inches and printed on archival quality paper in an open edition of 5,000 copies. A limited edition of 100 copies is produced on higher quality paper and numbered.

The posters are sold wholesale to sports organizations so it can be used as a fund-raiser while achieving widespread distribution which helps to promote Sport in Art as well as the sport that is illustrated.

5. To educate school children in these subject areas through a variety of programs including, but not limited to, historical, social and cultural exhibitions in the museum, touring exhibitions, juvenile publications and other activities which further promotes these educational objectives.
6. To publish academic works in these subject areas that might not otherwise be published in the commercial publishing area.
7. To collaborate or cooperate with other non-profit, educational institutions in programs or research projects which further the purposes of this institution.
8. To develop an endowment sufficient enough to maintain this institution in perpetuity.
